

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY
JUNE 10, 2019**

The Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Rensselaer met on June 10, 2019 in regular session in Council Chambers of City Hall. President Stephen Wood called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.


Answering roll call were: President Stephen Wood, Deputy Secretary Linda DeMoss, Board Member Rick Odle and Ernest Watson Jr., Police Chief Matt Anderson, Fire Chief Kenny Haun. Absent were: City Attorney Mike Riley, Project Coordinator Jerry Lockridge, Street Supt. Andy Daniel, and Nick Fiala with the Rensselaer Republican. Also in attendance was Scott Barton.

The minutes of the May 13, 2019 board meeting were presented to the board. There was a motion by Wood and second by Watson to approve the minutes. The motion passed unanimously.


Permits signed for fireworks at fairgrounds 6-29-19 rain date 6-30-19 & fireworks at fairgrounds 7-27-19 rain date 7-28-19: Police Chief Anderson said he had approved these dates on his end and needed approval and signatures on the applications. There was a motion by Odle, second by Watson, to approve the dates for fireworks at the fairgrounds. The motion passed unanimously.

Firefighter Application: Fire Chief Haun said he has an application for Justin Rich. The Fire Committee met last week and reviewed the application. The committee's recommendation is to put Rich on the roster with one year of probation. Rich has state certified training and is a graduate of the State Fire Academy. Rich is available during the daytime which is a huge plus. Haun said he was asking permission to put Rich on the roster starting July 1st. Odle made the motion to accept the firefighter application, second by Watson. The motion passed unanimously.

There being nothing more to come before the board, there was a motion by Watson, second by Odle, to adjourn. The motion passed unanimously and the meeting adjourned at 5:36 p.m.
