City of Rensselaer Water Utility Public Notice

For Immediate Release – January 9, 2023

With the impending cold weather that we may see over the next several days. Utility customers should take precautions to help prevent frozen meters and service lines. The City of Rensselaer Water Department would recommend these quick tips to protect your plumbing and fixtures.

1. Run a stream of water out of your faucets (Size of Pencil Lead) to keep water moving throughout your home or business.
2. Keep your kitchen and bathroom cabinet doors open to allow warmer air to circulate around plumbing fixtures. Be sure to move any harmful cleaners & household chemicals if you have small children and/or pets.
3. Ensure that all exterior block vents and access openings under your home or shut and well insulated.
4. The bare minimum it is recommended that you run faucets that are on exterior walls or infrequently used areas.
